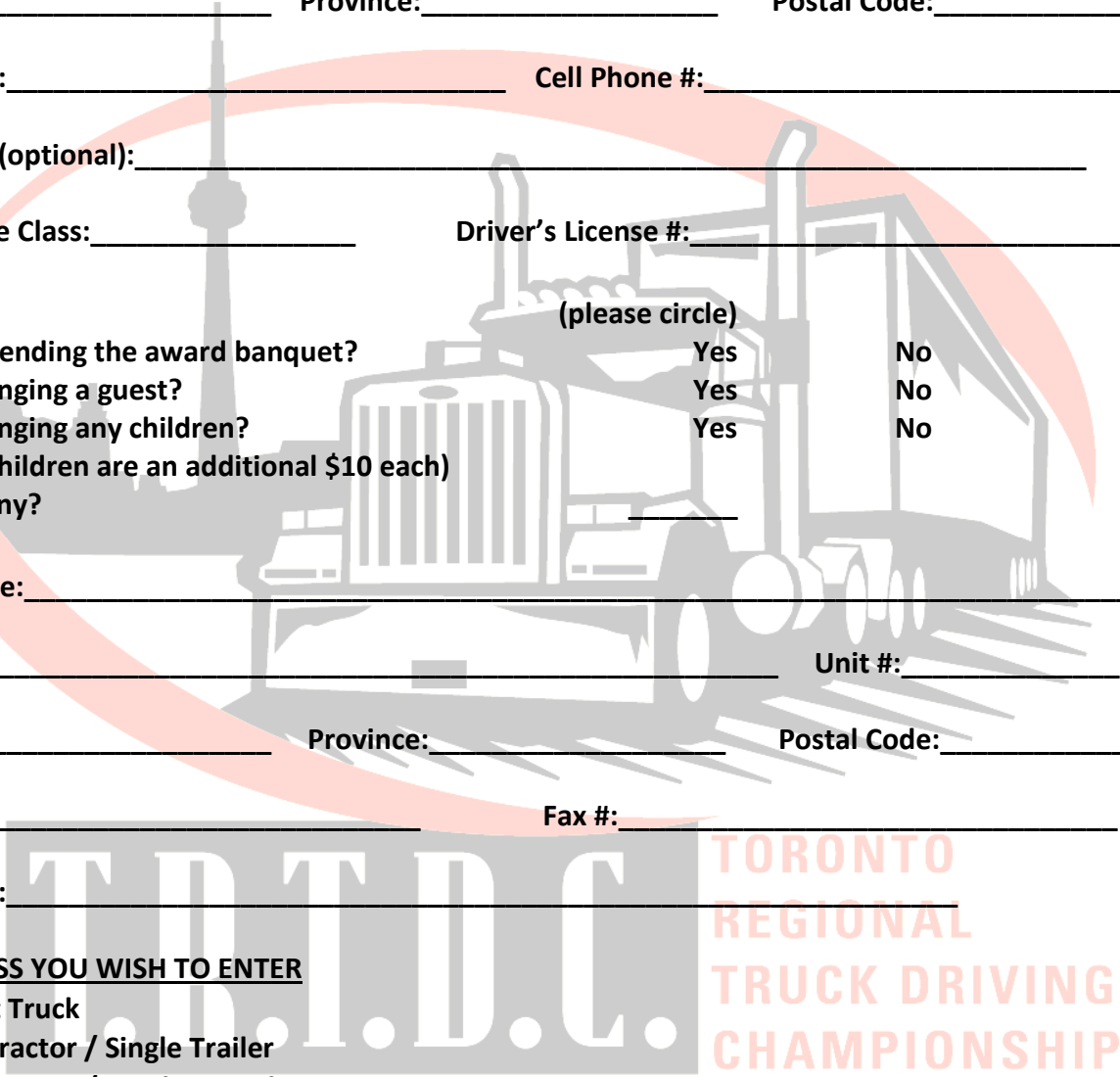

2. If applicant has been engaged by two employers since June 18, 2010, collision-free verifications from both employers must be submitted with this entry form.
3. Attach personal background form and complete release form.
4. The **personal background sheet**, this **entry form** and **entry fee of \$185.00** payable to "Toronto Regional Truck Driving Championship", which includes the meals for contestant and spouse/companion, must be included and post-dated no later than **June 2, 2011**. Any fees not paid prior to competition will render the driver ineligible to compete.

DRIVER CERTIFICATION and RELEASE

Eligibility Rules

1. You must be legally licensed to operate the class of vehicle in which you are competing;
2. You must compete in the jurisdiction in which your license was issued (i.e. Quebec licensed driver cannot compete in Ontario);
3. During the **12 months** preceding the date of the competition, you must:
 - Have performed the duties of a full-time professional truck driver for at least eleven months. Days off and vacation time to which you are entitled by your employer do not count against you.
 - Have been employed by no more than 2 employers.
 - Have had no preventable collisions. The definition of "preventable" in the Canada Safety Council Professional Driver's Improvement Course Manual will apply. (This rules applies to both personal vehicle accidents and commercial vehicle accidents);
 - Have had no suspensions to your license
4. During the **5 years** preceding the competition, you must have had no Criminal Code driving convictions registered against you;
5. You may participate in only one Regional Driving Championship in any year, and you may compete in only one class of competition in the year (i.e., straight truck, tandem-tandem, etc.).
6. A driver whose principal employment is for the movement of vehicles on private property, and who is generally referred to as a Spotter, Hostler, Switcher, Yardman or other similar description is eligible to compete.
7. The Toronto Regional Truck Driving Championship committee reserves the right to check all applications and disqualify any driver who does not meet the above requirements.
8. The Committee shall disqualify any contestant who, by a determination of two-thirds of the Committee members present, is guilty of conduct detrimental to the Toronto Regional Truck Driving Championship or the trucking industry. The decision of the Committee is final; the contestant does not have the right to appeal.
9. Contestants shall operate only the equipment authorized and supplied by the Toronto Regional Truck Driving Championship Committee.
10. No contestant will practice on a course laid out for this competition.
11. Owner Operators and/or Second Drivers are subject to the same rules regarding eligibility as company drivers.
12. Every contestant must complete, sign and cause to have witnessed the official entry form and submit same to the Registration Officer of the TRTDC committee.

Toronto Regional Truck Driving Championship Woodbine Shopping Centre June 18th, 2011
