The 65th Ontario Truck Driving Championships will be held at Mohawk Raceway, just west of Milton, July 9, 2011. Join an elite group of drivers competing for the opportunity to advance to the Nationals in Calgary September 8-11, 2011.

This year, in addition to the 5 usual (Straight, Single-Single, Single-Tandem, Tandem-Tandem, B-Train) classes, **exhibition classes** are being opened for **A- Train and Tanker Truck**. Drivers entering these exhibition classes will have a chance to win the same awards as the other classes. Any **interested individuals** can **entry one of the exhibition classes provided they meet the eligibility rules**. The entry fee for the exhibition class only is \$100. However, the winner of the exhibition class will not qualify to advance to the Nationals; the exhibition competitions are a demonstration event only. **If a driver enters only the exhibition class and wishes to attend the banquet they will be required to purchase tickets for this**. Also, if a driver wishes, he or she may enter **one** of the **other five classes** provided they have met the eligibility rules for the class they are registering in *and* exhibition class; see entry form for fee details. Note: If a driver registers for one of the five classes their meals are included in the entry fee.

Registration takes place at the Best Western Hotel, 161 Chisholm Dr. Milton on Friday from 3:00 pm to 9:00 pm, and Saturday morning 6-6:30 am.

The reception will be held at the hotel Friday night from 7:30 to 9:30 pm, offering everyone a chance to meet old friends and make new ones.

The drivers' written test will take place at Mohawk Raceway from 7:15 – 8:00 am, with the course walk-through scheduled for 8:15 a.m. sharp. No roll call will be taken at the walkthrough – it will proceed regardless of a driver being late.

Mohawk will be providing lunch on-site, and the OTDC and MTO Awards Banquet will be hosted by Mohawk as well.

Rooms are available at the Best Western for \$109 plus taxes (quote OTDC). Call 905-875-3818 or 1-800-249-1136 to reserve.

The Driver's Kit, used for all provincial and national competitions, will be forwarded to the competitor, or their company representative upon registration.

Attached is the registration form with instructions to complete for the competition including the Driver Personal Background form. The Background form provides information that will be announced to the spectators as the competitor starts on the obstacle course. Also attach the employer's letter and a recent driver's abstract with the payment and remit to the address below.

Driver registration includes all meals for the driver and spouse/guest from Saturday morning to Sunday morning, plus entrance to the Friday evening reception. If children are attending and require meals, please use the order form attached for this as it will assist with ordering meals and the seating plan for the banquet. Others who may wish to attend (employers, family, friends, etc.) may use this form as well.

NOTES TO EMPLOYER:

1. The employer must attach to the entry form a letter, on company letterhead, certifying that the driver meets all eligibility rules, and must attach a recent driver's abstract.
2. If applicant has been engaged by two employers since July 9, 2010, collision free verifications from both employers and insurance underwriters must be submitted with this entry form.
3. Attach personal background form and complete release form.
4. No contestant shall be permitted to use power equipment supplied by applicant's own company.
5. The **personal background sheet**, this **entry form** and **entry fee of \$260.00** payable to "Ontario Truck Driving Championships", which includes the meals for contestant and spouse/companion, must be included and post dated no later than **July 1, 2011**. Any fees not paid prior to competition will render the driver ineligible to compete.
6. If interested, drivers may enter *one* regular class (1 to 5 above) and either the A-Train or Tank Truck class. The fee for the two-class entry is **\$360**. Every effort will be made with scheduling to accommodate the driver's participation in two classes.

ONTARIO TRUCK DRIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS **ELIGIBILITY RULES**

In order to be eligible to compete in the Ontario Truck Driving Championships an applicant must:

1. Must be legally licensed to operate the class of vehicle for the event in which you are competing.
2. Must compete in the jurisdiction in which their license is issued.
3. During the 12 months preceding the date of the competition, you must:
 - Have performed the regular duties a full-time professional truck driver for at least 11 months prior to the competition. Days off and vacation time to which you are entitled by your employer do not count against you. In situations of extended time lost due to legitimate problems such as unintentional layoff or a WSIB claim, you **may** request to enter the Championships, and, depending on the length of time in question, eligibility may or may not be granted. Each request will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. The decision of the Committee is final.
 - Not have been employed by more than two (2) employers.
 - Have not had any preventable collisions for at least 12 months prior to the competition. The Infrastructure Health & Safety Association definition of preventable collision will apply.
 - Have not had your license suspended.
4. During the **5 Years** preceding the competition, you must not have had any Criminal Code driving convictions registered against you.
5. You may participate in only one Provincial Driving Championship in any year.
6. You may compete in only one class of competition e.g. straight truck, single-single, etc.
7. Any driver who is employed principally for the movement of vehicles on private property generally referred to as "Spotters", "Hostlers", "Switchers", "Yardmen", or however described is, eligible to enter Championship competitions and must meet all eligibility rules.
8. Contestants will not be permitted to use any powered equipment from their own company home terminal.
9. No contestant shall practice on a course laid out for competition.
10. The Executive Committee reserves the right to check all applications and disqualify any driver whose collision free record is not confirmed.
11. Every contestant must complete, sign and cause to have witnessed the official entry form and submit same to the Chairman of the Ontario Truck Driving Championships.
12. The Chairman of the Ontario Truck Driving Championships Committee shall disqualify any contestant who, by a determination of two-thirds of the Committee members present, is guilty of conduct obviously detrimental to the Ontario Truck Driving Championships or the trucking industry. Contestants do not have the right to appeal.
